#### 100% BUSINESS RATES HOLIDAY THROUGH TO THE END OF JUNE

followed by a two thirds discount with threshold for remaining nine months of the year.

## **RESTART GRANT SCHEME**

offering grants of up to £18,000 for firms in certain sectors.

### 'SUPER DEDUCTION' INVESTMENT INCENTIVE

For the next two years, companies can claim 130% capital allowances on qualifying investments.

# **OUR WINS FOR YOU**

#### APPRENTICESHIP INCENTIVES INCREASED TO £3K

and extended to September 2021. £126m of new funding to increase number of traineeships.

#### INTRODUCTION OF NEW FLEXI APPRENTICESHIP

Individuals will be linked to an agency, instead of a single employer, and take on different jobs with multiple businesses in one sector.

## HELP TO GROW SCHEME

A subsidised executive development programme, free digital skills training and 50% discount on approved software.

### VISA REFORMS FOR HIGHLY SKILLED MIGRANTS

A new unsponsored visa and faster process to support fintech.

Despite a number of welcome announcements in the budget, there are still many businesses and individuals who have, through no fault of their own, been unable to access any government support since the start of the pandemic.

The BCC will continue to make the case for those who are currently excluded from government support to get the help they need to navigate a difficult few months ahead before the economy is able to reopen more fully.
